**Statement by Most Rev. John O'Mara
 Bishop Emeritus of St. Catharines**

“On one occasion, in a private conversation, sometime late in 1992 when I was Bishop of Thunder Bay, Bishop Joseph R. Windle, Bishop of the Diocese of Pembroke asked me whether or not he should notify the Holy See that he had received an allegation of sexual misconduct concerning Fr. Bernard Prince who had recently been seconded to Rome to serve the Church in an administrative position.

I encouraged Bishop Windle to report the matter and I have had no other information or involvement with respect to the situation”
