## God is a Family

Dear Family in Christ,

How can we speak of what, or *who*, God is? By philosophical reasoning, we can know that there *is* a God. It is only by way of God revealing Himself, ultimately in the Incarnation, in the person of Jesus Christ, that we can begin to know who He is. God is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit: three distinct persons, in one divine nature.

We also know that God is love, which begins to make sense of how He could be three persons in one: a lover, a beloved, and the love between them, united as a *life-giving communion of love*. The Father perfectly loves the Son, and the Son perfectly receives and returns the Father’s love, and the love between them is so perfect that it is itself a person- the Holy Spirit. Does this sound at all familiar?

When God created man, the book of Genesis tells us that He made us in *His own image and likeness- male and female He created them*. In other words, God imprinted and infused His very identity into ours. In making us male and female, we have been made for love. In the divinely instituted covenant and Sacrament of Marriage, the love between husband and wife that makes them one flesh naturally brings forth another (or more) person(s). It can rightly be said that man most perfectly reflects the image and likeness of God in the *family*.

It should come as no surprise that Satan attacks the family with everything he has. We all experience this attack, within ourselves and those we love. Whether it be infidelity and divorce, fornication and pornography, abortion and contraception, and “2SLGBTQI+” ideology, the prophecy of Our Lady at Fatima over a century ago is coming true: the final battle between Satan and Christ will be fought over marriage and the family.

We fight this battle on a cultural front, but also a personal one. Each of us, myself first of all, must surrender our own struggles with sin, our disordered desires, and failures to love in God’s image to His grace, love, and mercy. The Good News is that we not only bear His image within us, but also share in His divine life, in His life-giving communion of love! God wants us to be part of His family today, and for eternity in Heaven. Will we say yes?
