Today we celebrate the **Feast of Divine Mercy**. The Lord wanted it to be for all, but especially for great sinners, an abundant source of forgiveness and divine graces. Through Faustina's Diary Jesus passed on to the whole world his promises related to the Feast.

1. "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of Divine Mercy shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment." (Diary 699)
2. "Souls who spread the honour of My mercy I shield through their entire lives as a tender mother her infant, and at the hour of death I will not be a Judge for them, but the Merciful Saviour" (Diary 1075)
3. "On that day all the divine floodgates through which grace flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet." (Diary, 699).
4. "My Daughter, encourage souls to say the chaplet. It pleases Me to grant everything they ask of Me by saying the chaplet (Diary 1541) Let all men now approach the throne of my mercy with absolute confidence!"



Thus today the Divine Heart is fully open. Every sinner, every lost person, every oppressed can find there a refuge and peace. The basic requirements for the Divine Mercy devotion are:

1. Celebrate the Feast on the Sunday after Easter;
2. Sincerely repent for all your sins;
3. Place your complete trust in Jesus;
4. Be in a state of grace or go to Sacramental Confession, before that Sunday;
5. Receive Holy Communion on the day of the Feast (I, 130; II, 138);
6. Venerate the Image of The Divine Mercy;
7. Be merciful to others, through our actions, words, and prayers on their behalf.

Today we can receive a plenary indulgence even if our detachment from sin is not perfect. Let us immerse ourselves and our families in the Divine Mercy.
